<p>On Line Safety: Pupils should know what to do if they encounter inappropriate images or other content while searching online. Pupils should respect the intellectual property of others. Show them how they can restrict their search to Creative Commons licensed content. In filming one another, the pupils need to ensure that the appropriate permission has been obtained, and that they act respectfully and responsibly when filming, editing and presenting their work. The pupils should think through the implications of videos being made available on the school network or more widely via the Internet. They should discuss why schools and other organisations have strict policies over filming</p>
